Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan's vision, as inspired by its founding father Dr. K M Munshi, is to revive and uphold Indian culture while integrating it with education. To achieve this, the Kendra established the Centre for Indology and Culture, focusing on Odisha's maritime heritage.

The Centre has been working to preserve Odisha's lost art and culture through a Cultural Outreach Programme, in collaboration with Infosys Foundation. This initiative has led to the organization of 175 episodes, including eight cultural programs conducted between May and June 2025.
